
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019-2023

 UN Women encourages DOS to focus attention on the two indicators rated as approaching requirements, Gender Architecture and Capacity Assessment.




COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2019-2023

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




From 2019 to 2023, DOS maintained a strong performance above the average of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System.
