
The following three pages capture ICAO's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2018-2023.

#### **PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2023**

### **Most significant gains**

- ICAO exceeded requirements for four indicators and met them for another five indicators.
- Significantly in 2023, ICAO newly exceeded the requirements for the Audit indicator and met them for the Gender Architecture and Organizational Culture indicators.


## **Areas for improvement**

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In both 2018 and 2023, ICAO outperformed the average of entities with a Technical focus. While ICAO surpassed the overall UN System in 2018, the UN System outperformed ICAO in 2023 on average.

**COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2023** 



In 2023, ICAO met and exceeded requirements for slightly more indicators than similar entities with a Technical focus, while trailing the average performance of the UN System. The entity did not miss any indicators.

## **COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2023**



From 2018 to 2023, ICAO sustained solid progress by exceeding a greater proportion of indicators.

In 2023, the entity improved upon its 2022 performance by meeting and exceeding three additional indicators, and by approaching two more indicators, marking its strongest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance to date.
