

Most significant gains

- OSRSG-SVC exceeded the requirements for eleven indicators and met them for another five indicators.
- Remarkably in 2023, OSRSG-SVC newly exceeded the requirements for the Capacity Assessment indicator.

Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages OSRSG-SVC to continue to build upon its achievements and work toward exceeding requirements on the five indicators rated as meeting requirements.


COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2023

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In both 2018 and 2023, OSRSG-SVC maintained a strong performance above the averages of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System.
