
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2018-2023

- UN-Habitat exceeded the requirements for two indicators and met them for another nine indicators.

Areas for improvement


 UN Women encourages increased attention on the five indicators rated missing or approaching requirements.


COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2018-2023

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In 2018, UN-Habitat outperformed the UN Secretariat entities and the overall UN System on average. In 2023, the UN Secretariat entities and the UN System, on average, outperformed UN-Habitat.





In 2023, UN-Habitat exceeded the requirements for less indicators than the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System on average. The entity missed the requirements for more indicators in comparison.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2018-2023



In both 2022 and 2023, UN-Habitat sustained solid progress by meeting and exceeding the requirements for significantly greater proportion of indicators.

In 2023, the entity improved upon its 2022 performance by meeting the requirements for three additional indicators, marking its strongest UN-SWAP 2.0 performance up to date.
