
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2021-2023

Areas for improvement




COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2021-2023

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In both 2021 and 2023, UNRISD outperformed the Training institutes and the overall UN System on average.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2023



In 2023, UNRISD exceeded the requirements for significantly more indicators than the averages of Training institutes entities and the UN System. The entity assessed more indicators as not applicable.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2021-2023



From 2021 to 2023, UNRISD maintained solid progress by exceeding the requirements for a greater proportion of indicators.

In 2023, the entity slightly trailed its 2022 performance, with two indicators downgraded from exceeding to meeting or approaching requirements.
