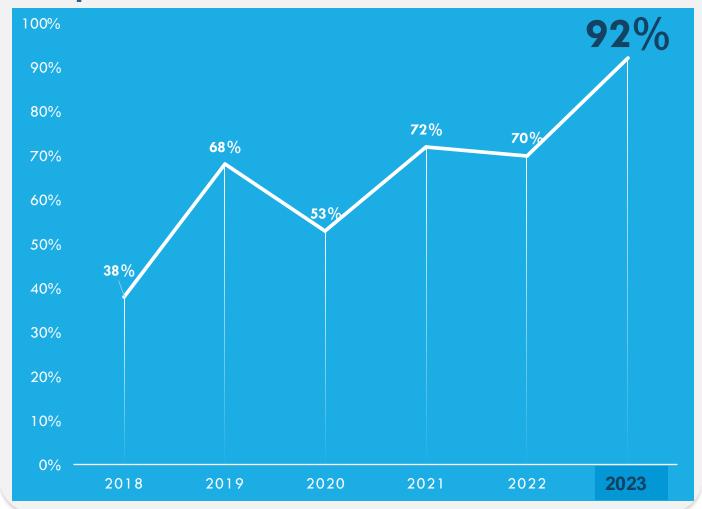


OVERVIEW OF UNBOA 2023 AUDIT

IMPACT OF IMPLEMENTING RECOMMENDATIONS



Principled Performance

- Strengthened risk assessment and validation through new guidance on risk propensity scales and risk tolerance levels
- New Planning, Monitoring, and Reporting Policy allows for standardized result tracking
- Increased compliance with completion of mandatory trainings through automated notifications
- Improved environmental indicators with the implementation of the Social and Environmental Sustainability Policy
- Marked reduction in partner audit financial findings, with more effective programme partner selection

Advancing Partnerships and Resourcing

- Enhanced transparency and fund traceability through the UN Women Transparency Portal, with clear links to progress towards the SDGs
- The "Close and Learn Procedure from the Programme Partner Project Procedure" increased collaboration and accountability for the closure of partner agreements
- The new Private Sector Engagement Policy and Procedure helped forge strategic privatesector partnerships to advance gender equality and achieve programme objectives

- Optimized organizational efficiency and effectiveness with a successful upgrade to a new globally accessible Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system, Quantum

- Streamlined processes by having long-term agreements for recurring goods and services
