2. Strategic plan

Pursuant to its decision 2011/3, paragraph 9 ([UNW/2011/13](#)), the Executive Board will consider the annual progress report of the Under-Secretary-General/Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN-Women) on the Entity's strategic plan, 2011-2013.

3. Evaluation

The Executive Board will be presented with the report on the evaluation function of UN-Women, 2013 ([UNW/2014/3](#)) and the corporate evaluation plan for 2014-2017. In accordance with Executive Board decisions 2012/9 ([UNW/2012/16](#)) and 2013/4 ([UNW/2013/11](#)) and in line with the Entity's adherence to the evaluation norms and standards of the United Nations Evaluation Group, the report assesses the performance of the Entity's evaluation function against the key performance indicators of a global evaluation oversight system. The report also describes actions taken to achieve system-wide coordination of the evaluation of gender equality and the empowerment of women and to support national and regional capacities for such evaluation.

The joint evaluation of joint programmes on gender equality in the United Nations system will also be presented. In 2012 and 2013, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), UN-Women and the Millennium Development Goals Fund, in partnership with the Governments of Norway and Spain, undertook a joint evaluation of such programmes to address a gap in evaluative evidence on joint gender programmes implemented at the country level after 2006. The report contains four overarching recommendations, directed to United Nations entities (including the United Nations Development Group), host Governments, civil society and donors, to improve the next generation of programmes on gender equality.
