








UN-Women's strengthened programme development capacity






UN-Women's strengthened programme focus

1st Donor Round Table

- Discuss and validate the Flagship Programme's Theory of Change (TOC) and strategy
- Agree on costing / potential sources of finance

2nd Donor Round Table Decide on burden sharing amongst various partners
