Uneven and insufficient progress in implementation of Beijing **Declaration and Platform for Action** Violence Against Women remains a human rights violation and highly prevalent across regions Persistence of discriminatory norms, values and practices Increased number and duration in conflicts and crises Repositioning of multilateral system **COVID-19 Pandemic**

Opportunities

- Growing visibility of women leaders, focus on women's leadership at CSW 65
- Increasing awareness of how gender equality can lead to more effective policies for all
- Increasing international commitment (and financing) to meet SDG goals (SDG-5)
- More attention given to addressing different forms of VAW globally
- Strong commitment to WPS through NAPs, normative framework, IEG mechanism, etc.
- Increased demands for gender data and research to address the impact of COVID-19 and inform the global response
- Increased recognition as global technical expert on engendering fiscal stimulus
- Increasing opportunities to leverage technology and innovation to deliver results at scale across operational work


