



### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

#### Most significant gains


- In 2019, OSRSG-CAAC exceeded requirements for the Audit and Gender-responsive Performance Management indicators.
- Significantly, performance on the Policy indicator has increased from approaching to meeting requirements. We are pleased to note OSRSG-CAAC's reconsideration of the previously not applicable rating for Financial Resource Tracking, now marked as approaching requirements.

#### Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages OSRSG-CAAC to reconsider the applicability of the Financial Resource Allocation indicator, as setting financial benchmarks for gender work ensures that OSRSG-CAAC will be able to prioritize work towards gender equality.

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

- OSRSG-CAAC's 2019 UN-SWAP 2.0 performance is significantly above average.
- In 2019, OSRSG-CAAC performed notably better than both the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN System at large.

## OSRSG-CAAC, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2019, OSRSG-CAAC increased its performance from 2018 results by 1 indicator in the exceeding requirements category. Furthermore, between 2019 and 2018, the indicators marked as not applicable have decreased by 12 percentage points, signifying OSRSG-CAAC's increasingly comprehensive usage of the UN-SWAP 2.0 framework.
