

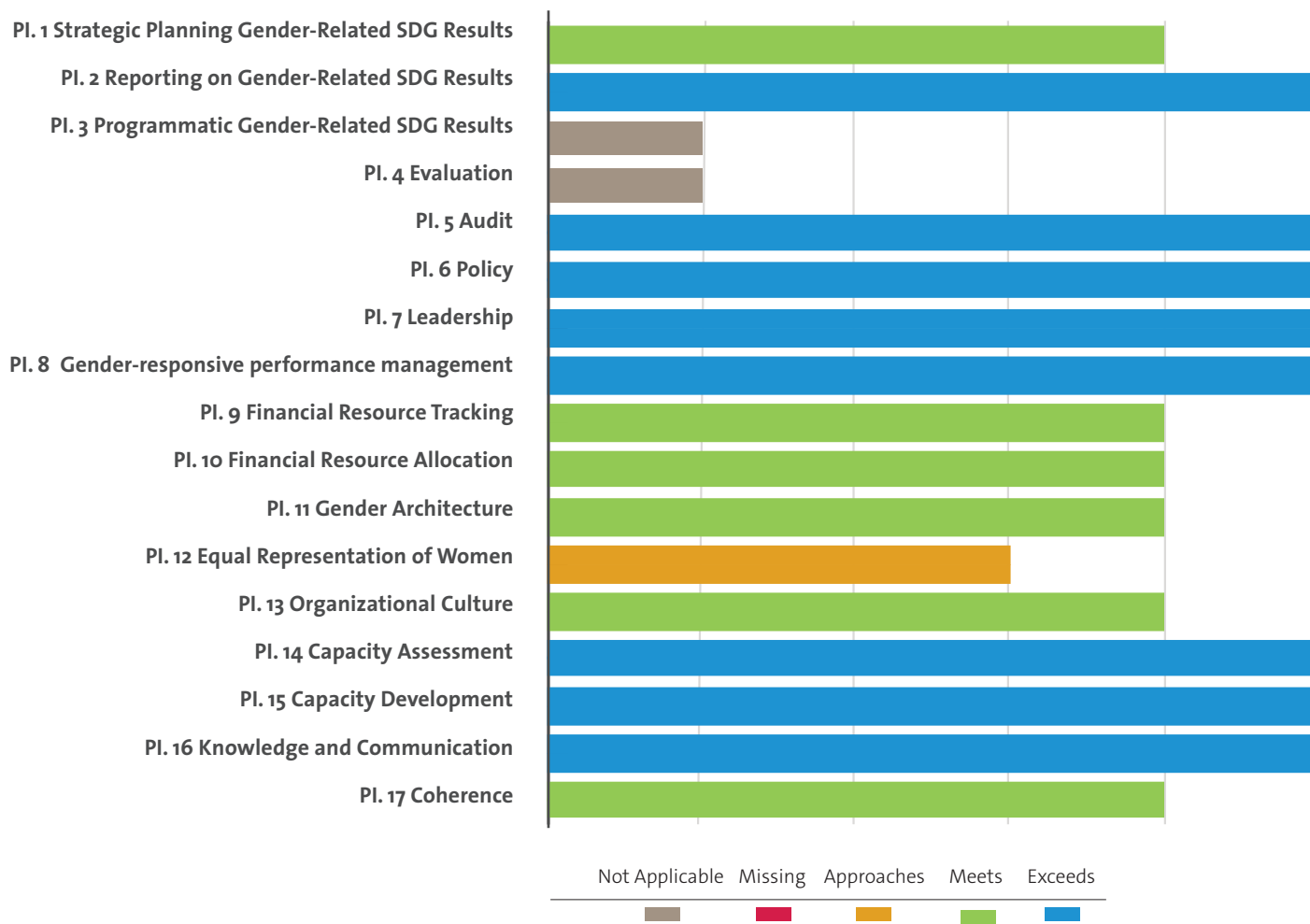
UNITED NATIONS DEPARTMENT OF PEACE OPERATIONS (DPO) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

The following two pages capture DPO's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, DPO met or exceeded the requirements for 14 performance indicators out of 15 applicable.

DPO's progress towards meeting UN-SWAP 2.0 requirements is significantly above average.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

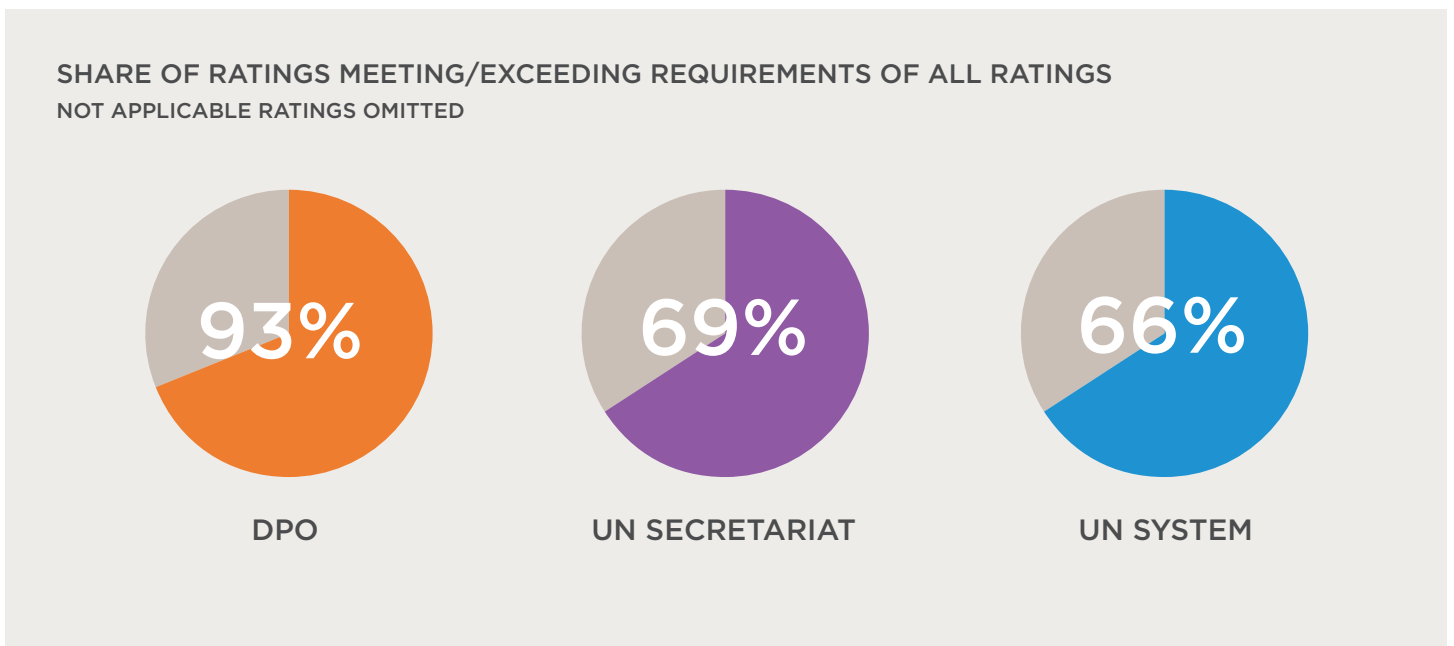
Most significant gains

- In 2019, DPO exceeded the requirements for 8 indicators, including Reporting on Gender-Related SDG Results and Capacity Assessment.
- Particularly, exceeding requirements for the Leadership indicator is a notable achievement, as senior leadership commitment to advance gender equality is a key driver of progress.

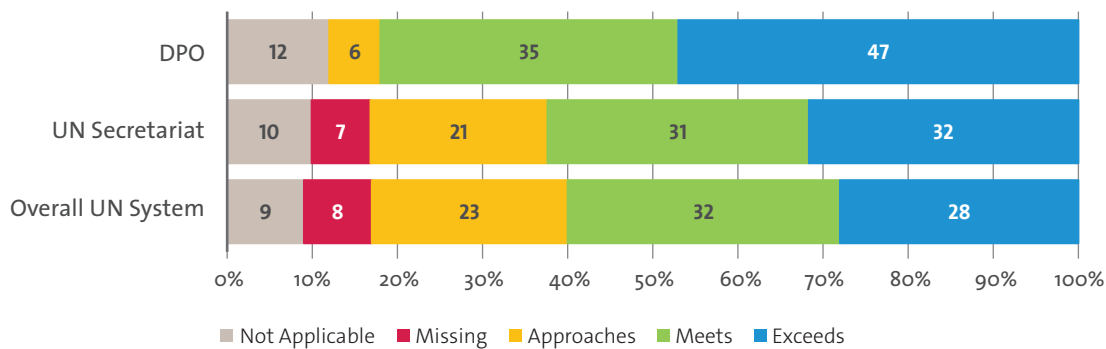
Areas for improvement

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DPO

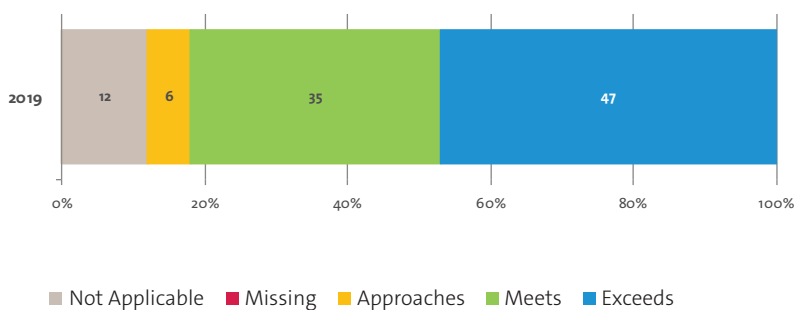


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

- DPO’s 2019 UN-SWAP 2.0 performance is significantly above average.
- In 2019, DPO performed notably better than both the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN system at large.

- In 2019, DPO met or exceeded requirements for 82 per cent of indicators
- DPO’s performance in 2019 constitutes a promising baseline toward meeting or exceeding all UN-SWAP 2.0 requirements by the 2022 deadline.
