

Areas for improvement


• UN Women encourages DPPA to focus on Financial Resource Allocation, the only indicator marked as approaching requirements.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR DPPA




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS INCLUDED



- DPPA meets or exceeds a significantly higher percentage of indicators than the aggregate performance of the Secretariat and the overall UN system.
- In 2019, DPPA deemed all 17 indicators
 applicable without missing the requirements of any indicator.

DPPA, ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- The restructuring and consolidation of DPA and PBSO in 2019, forming DPPA, confirms a positive outcome in relation to UN-SWAP compliance.
- In 2019, DPPA met 47 per cent of all indicators, as well as exceeded another 47 per cent of indicators. This commendable commitment to gender equality is well reflected in DPPA's 2019 report.
