

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019


Most significant gains

- Furthermore, ECLAC continues to meet requirements for Financial Resource Allocation and Policy, both essential drivers for progress.


Areas for improvement

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ECLAC




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

• In 2019, ECLAC met or exceeded requirements for more indicators than both the average for the UN Secretariat and for the overall UN system.

ECLAC, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2019, ECLAC witnessed a 12 percentage point increase in indicators that exceeded requirements, thereby meeting or exceeding requirements for 71 per cent of indicators, compared to 65 per cent in 2018. Furthermore, ECLAC did not miss requirements for any indicators in 2019.
