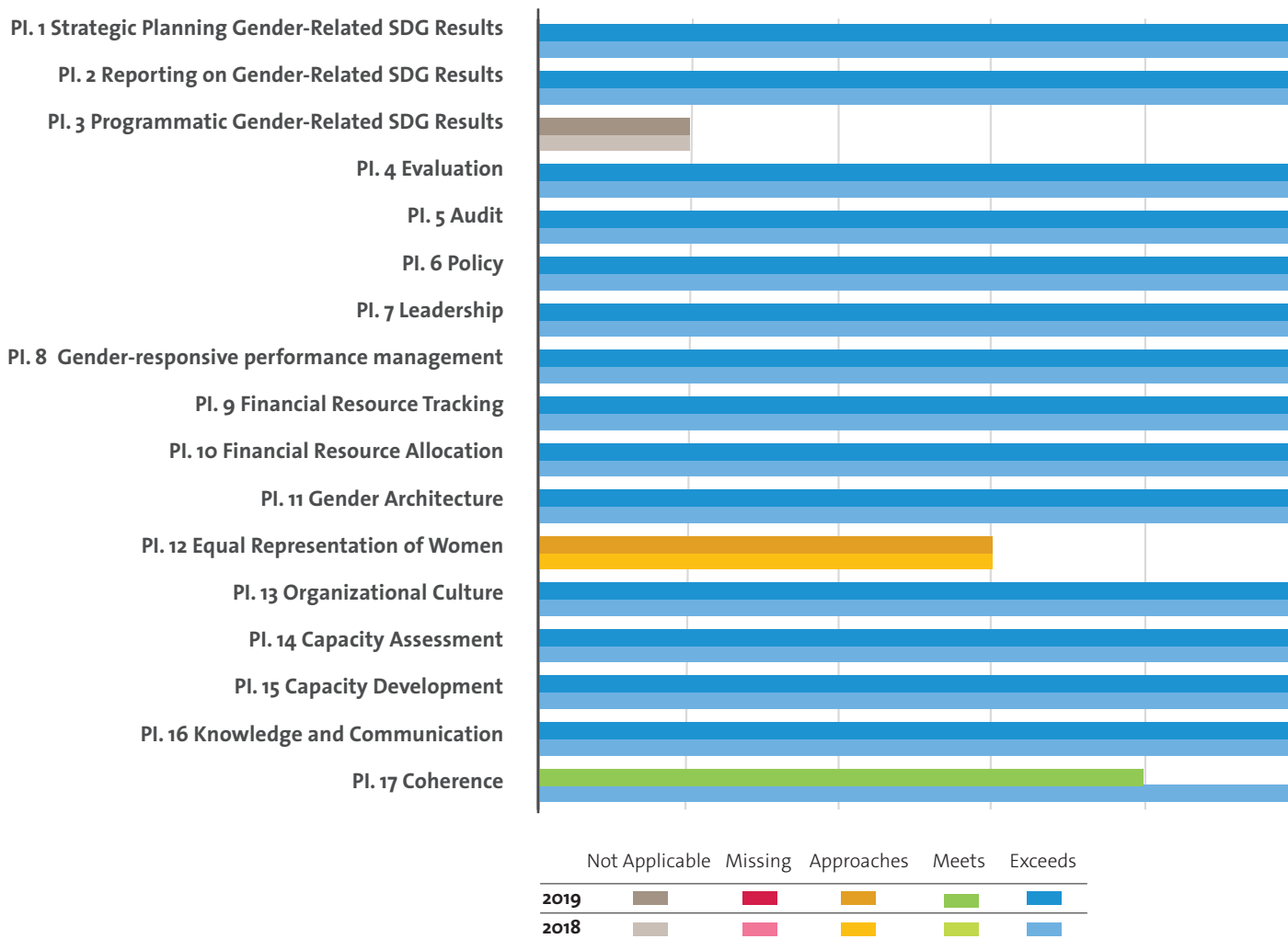
UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

The following two pages capture ESCWA's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, ESCWA met or exceeded the requirements for 15 performance indicators out of 16 applicable.

ESCWA's progress towards meeting UN.SWAP 2.0 requirements is significantly above average.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

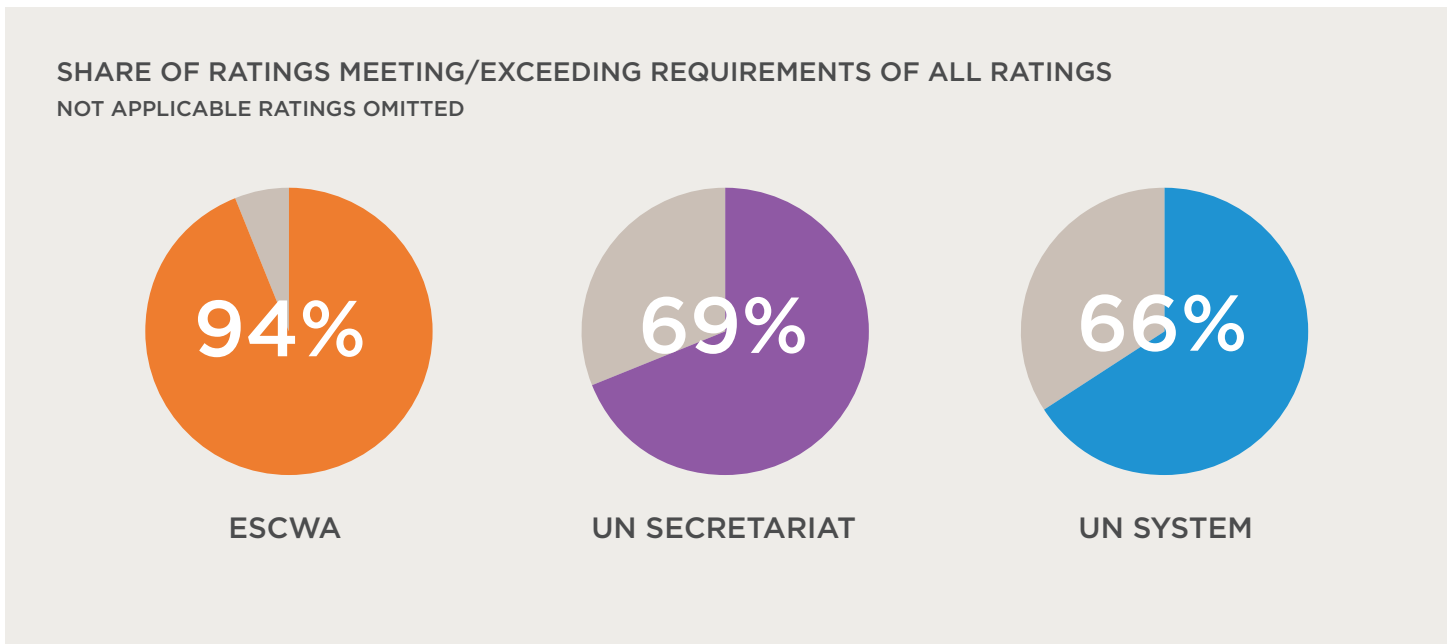
Most significant gains

- ESCWA continues to exceed requirements on 14 out of the 17 performance indicators. UN Women commends ESCWA on its comprehensive commitment to the UN-SWAP and to achieving gender equality.

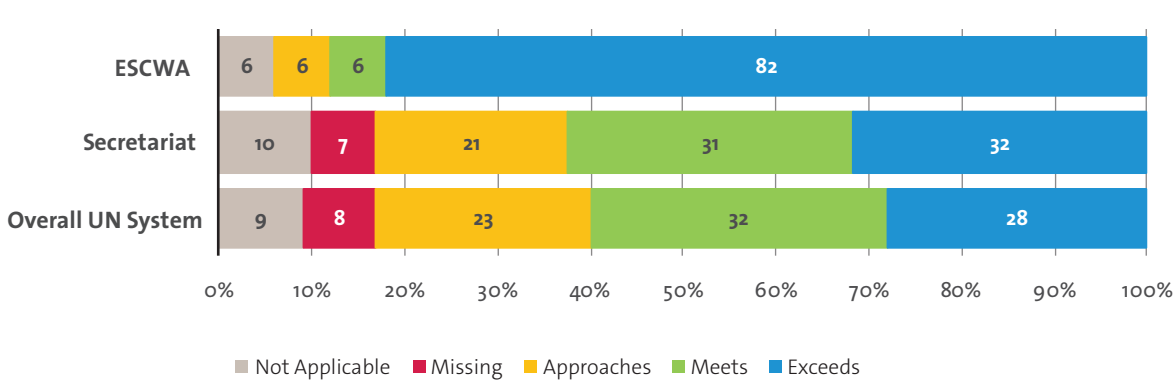
Areas for improvement

- UN Women recommends that ESCWA focus on the Equal Representation of Women, the only indicator approaching requirements. Furthermore, UN Women also encourages ESCWA to continue working on the Coherence indicator, the only indicator which has declined in performance from 2018.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ESCWA

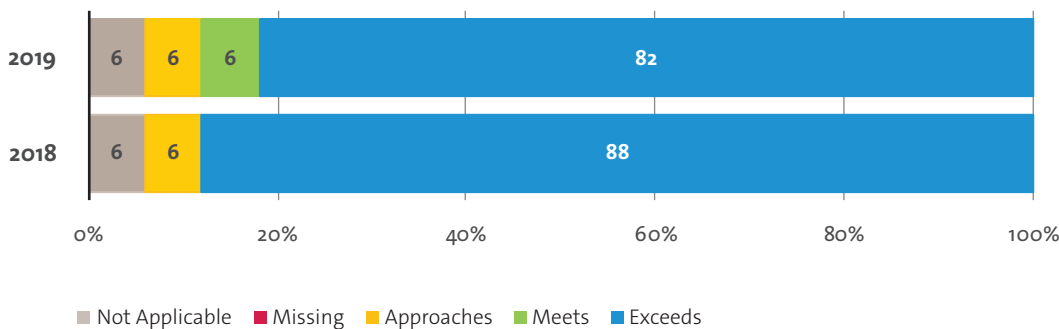


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

• ESCWA continues to lead the overall UN System, as well as other UN Secretariat entities, in UN-SWAP 2.0 compliance across all rating categories.

• Throughout 2018 and 2019, ESCWA maintained impressive results, exceeding or meeting 88 per cent of all indicator requirements. One indicator, Coherence, declined from exceeding to meeting requirements in 2019.
