


FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION (FAO) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

In 2019, FAO met or exceeded the requirements for 15 performance indicators out of 16 applicable.

FAO's progress towards meeting UN-SWAP 2.0 requirements is significantly above average.

Most significant gains



Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages FAO to prioritize the Equal Representation of Women, as the only indicator marked as approaching requirements.

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED




COMPARISON WITH SPECIALIZED ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
