


INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION (ILO) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

In 2019, ILO met or exceeded the requirements for 9 performance indicators out of 17 applicable, an improvement in comparison with 2018 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

Most significant gains

- In 2019, ILO met or exceeded requirements for nine indicators.
- Significantly, ILO newly met requirements for Policy and Financial Resource Tracking, and exceeded requirements on Reporting on Gender-Related SDG Results.

Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages ILO to focus increased efforts on the indicators marked as approaching requirements, and in particular the Equal Representation of Women and Financial Resource Allocation.




COMPARISON WITH SPECIALIZED ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
