



UNITED NATIONS OFFICE FOR DISASTER RISK REDUCTION (UNDRR) UN-SWAP 2.0



The following two pages capture UNDRR's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, UNDRR met or exceeded the requirements for 13 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, a significant improvement from 2018 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

Most significant gains

- In 2019, UNDRR has increased performance on several indicators. In particular, UNDRR is now exceeding requirements on Strategic Planning Gender-Related SDG Results and Gender-Responsive Performance Management.
- Furthermore, performance has increased from approaching to meeting requirements on Reporting on Gender-Related SDG Results.

Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages UNDRR to focus on the three indicators marked as approaching requirements: Financial Resource Allocation, Equal Representation of Women and Coherence.
- UN Women also recommends the prioritization of the Policy indicator, which has seen a decline in performance from exceeding to meeting requirements.

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED




COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

- UNDRR’s 2019 UN-SWAP 2.0 performance is significantly above average.
- In 2019, UNDRR performed notably better than both the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN System at large.

UNDRR, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- UNDRR’s performance shows great progress in comparison with 2018.
- In 2019, UNDRR met 6 indicators and exceeded 7 indicators for a total of 76 per cent of indicators in the meeting and exceeding category, a 6 percentage point increase from 2018. Furthermore, there were no indicators marked as missing in 2019.
- Only one indicator is marked as not applicable.
