
UNITED NATIONS ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME (UNEP) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

In 2019, UNEP met or exceeded the requirements for 8 performance indicators out of 17 applicable, a significant improvement from the 2018 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

Most significant gains

- 2019 has been a year of commendable progress for UNEP. Most significantly, UNEP newly met requirements for Policy and Programmatic Gender-Related SDG Results.
- Furthermore, UNEP is exceeding requirements on Gender-Responsive Performance Management.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNEP to prioritize the indicators that missed or approached requirements.
- In particular, UN Women highlights the importance of Financial Resource Tracking and Allocation, as well as the Equal Representation of Women.




COMPARISON WITH THE UN SECRETARIAT AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS INCLUDED



- In 2019, UNEP exceeded requirements for fewer indicators than both the average for the UN Secretariat and the overall UN system.
- Commendably, UNEP did not rate any indicators as not applicable. In comparison, on average the UN Secretariat and the UN system as a whole rated 10 per cent and 9 per cent of indicators as not applicable, respectively.

UNEP, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2019, UNEP exceeded requirements for 2 indicators and met them for 6 indicators, thereby meeting and exceeding requirements for 47 per cent of the performance indicators, a 23 percentage point increase from 2018.
