

Most significant gains


- In its first year of reporting on the UN-SWAP 2.0, UNICRI met or exceed the requirements for 7 indicators.
- In particular, we commend UNICRI for exceeding the Knowledge and Communication indicator by globally disseminating good practices and available tools to counter gender-based discrimination and violence.

Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages UNICRI to reconsider the applicability of the 6 indicators marked as not applicable.
- The Financial Resource Tracking and Allocation indicators are essential to support gender work, which cannot succeed without sufficient human and financial resources.



COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR UNICRI




COMPARISON WITH TRAINING INSTITUTES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS INCLUDED



- In 2019, UNICRI met or exceeded slightly less indicators than the average for the training institutes.
- UNICRI exceeded significantly less indicators than the average for the UN System.

UNICRI, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2019, 41 per cent of the indicators were rated meeting or exceeding requirements, while 35 per cent of the indicators were rated not applicable.
- Incorporating these indicators into UNICRI's work will greatly enhance 2020 performance and results.
- UNICRI reported for the first time in the 2019 reporting cycle. In the next cycle, this graph will show comparison with previous year's results.
