



## UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

The following two pages capture UNOV/UNODC's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, UNOV/UNODC met or exceeded the requirements for 10 performance indicators out of 17 applicable, a significant improvement from 2018 results.

#### PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

##### Most significant gains


- In 2019, significant progress has been made on the following three indicators, all of which have progressed from meeting to exceeding requirements: Gender-Responsive Performance Management, Capacity Assessment and Knowledge and Communication. Commendably, UNOV/UNODC has maintained excellent performance on Policy and Leadership, among other indicators.

##### Areas for improvement


- UN Women encourages UNOV/UNODC to prioritize the 4 indicators approaching requirements and the 2 missing indicators. In particular, UN Women emphasizes the importance of Financial Resource Tracking and Allocation, as well as the Equal Representation of Women. Sustained financial resources and gender parity are essential criteria for achieving gender equality.


SHARE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS OF ALL RATINGS




## COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

- In 2019, UNOV/UNODC trailed the performance of both the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN System at large.
- UNOV/UNODC exceeded more indicators than both the average for the UN Secretariat and the UN System as a whole.

## UNOV/UNODC COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2019, UNOV/UNODC exceeded requirements for 6 indicators, 3 more indicators than in 2018.
- Additionally, the percentage of indicators approaching requirements has declined by one indicator, which in 2019 improved to meeting requirements.
