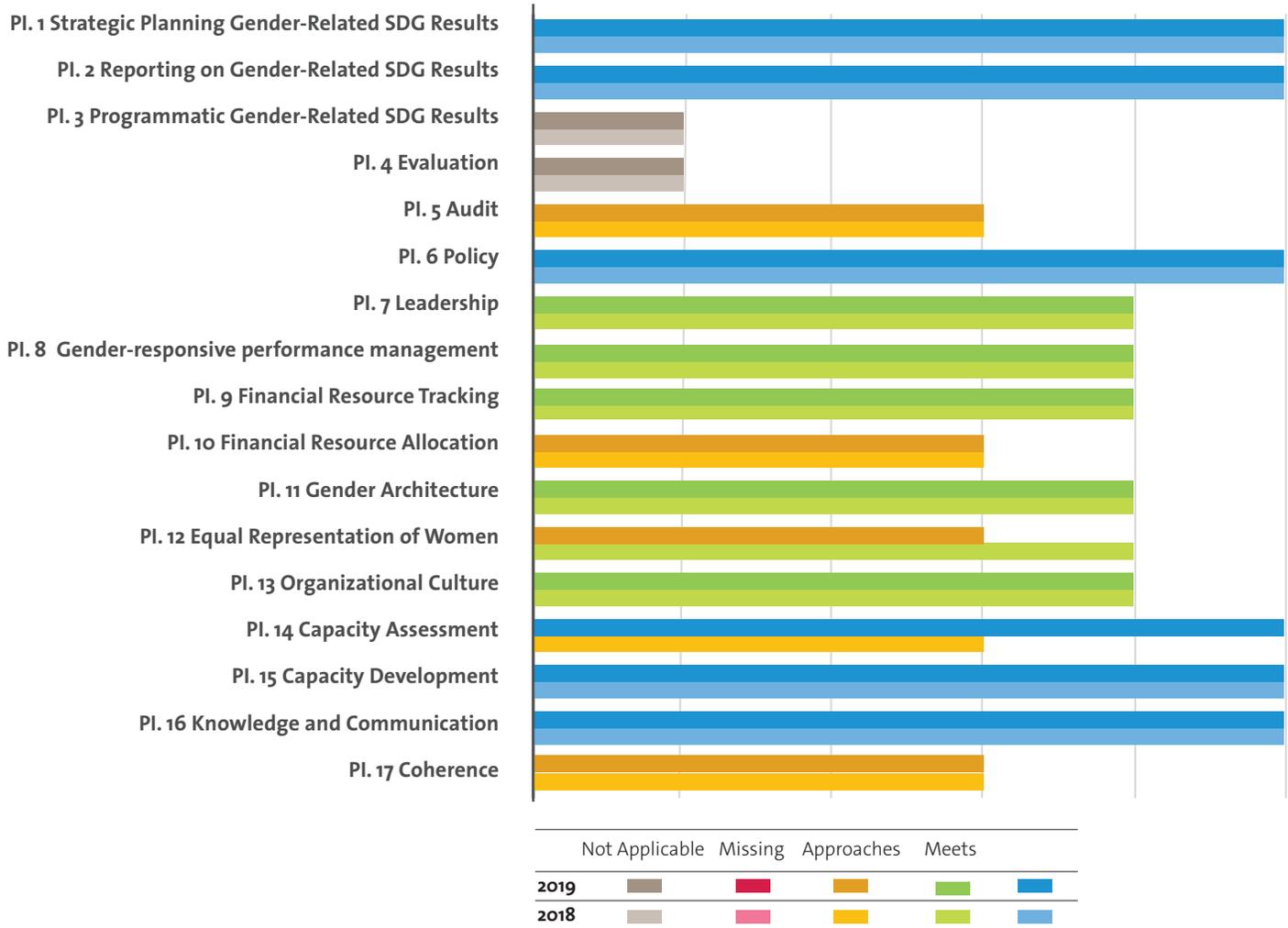


UNITED NATIONS UNIVERSITY (UNU) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

In 2019, UNU met or exceeded the requirements for 11 performance indicators out of 15 applicable, maintaining the strong performance of 2018 results.

Most significant gains

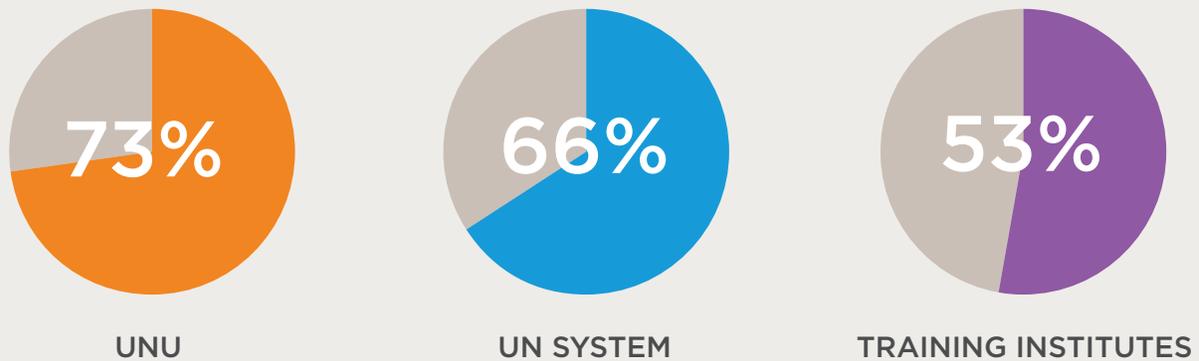
- In 2019, UNU maintained its strong performance from 2018, exceeding or meeting requirements for 11 indicators.
- Furthermore, UNU exceeded requirements for Capacity Assessment, previously approaching requirements.

Areas for improvement

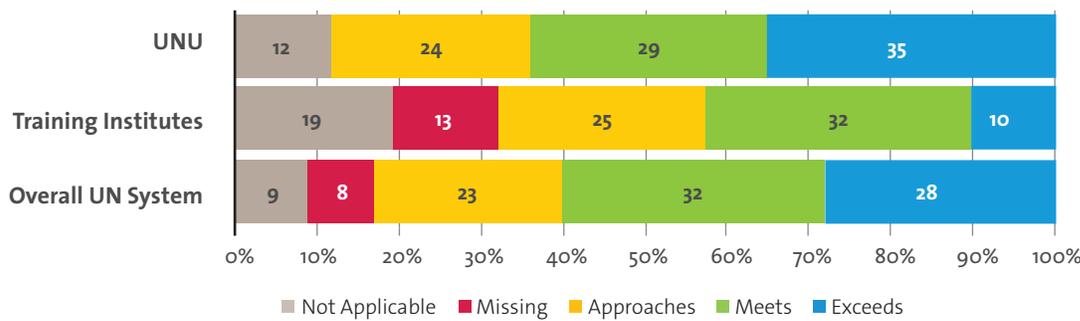
- UN Women encourages UNU to prioritize the four indicators approaching requirements: Audit, Coherence and, in particular, Financial Resource Allocation and the Equal Representation on Women.

- In 2019, UNU met or exceeded requirements for more indicators than both the average for the Training Institutes and the overall UN System.
- In addition, UNU did not miss requirements for any indicators. In comparison, on average, the Training Institutes and the UN system as a whole missed requirements for 13 per cent and 8 per cent of indicators, respectively.

UNU, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



- In 2019, UNU exceeded requirements for 6 indicators and met them for another 5 indicators, thereby maintaining the aggregate performance in these two categories at 64 per cent.
- In 2019, UNU exceeded requirements for 35 per cent of indicators, an increase of 6 percentage points from 2018.
