


UNITED NATIONS VOLUNTEERS (UNV) UN-SWAP 2.0

In 2019, UNV met or exceeded the requirements for 10 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, a significant improvement from 2018 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019


Most significant gains

- For the first time on the UN-SWAP 2.0, UNV exceeded requirements for 2 indicators, Leadership and Knowledge and Communication.
- Impressively, UNV also met requirements for 8 out of 16 applicable indicators. UN Women commends UNV, particularly on meeting the Financial Resource Tracking and Policy indicators, both of which reflect commitment to and prioritization of systemic gender work.


Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages UNV to focus on Financial Resource Allocation, the only indicator rated as missing requirements, and a necessity for gender work which cannot succeed without consistent human and financial resources.
- In addition to this, UN Women recommends giving attention to the 5 indicators marked as approaching requirements.
