


WORLD FOOD PROGRAM (WFP) UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

The following two pages capture WFP's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, WFP met or exceeded the requirements for 13 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, maintaining the strong performance registered in 2018.

WFP's progress towards meeting UN-SWAP 2.0 requirements is significantly above average.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019


Most significant gains

- In 2019, WFP maintained the strong performance registered in 2018, exceeding requirements for nine indicators and meeting requirements for four indicators.
- WFP counts on an impressive Gender Results Network with 703 members, encompassing all country offices, regional bureaux and HQ divisions.


Areas for improvement




COMPARISON WITH FUNDS & PROGRAMMES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
