

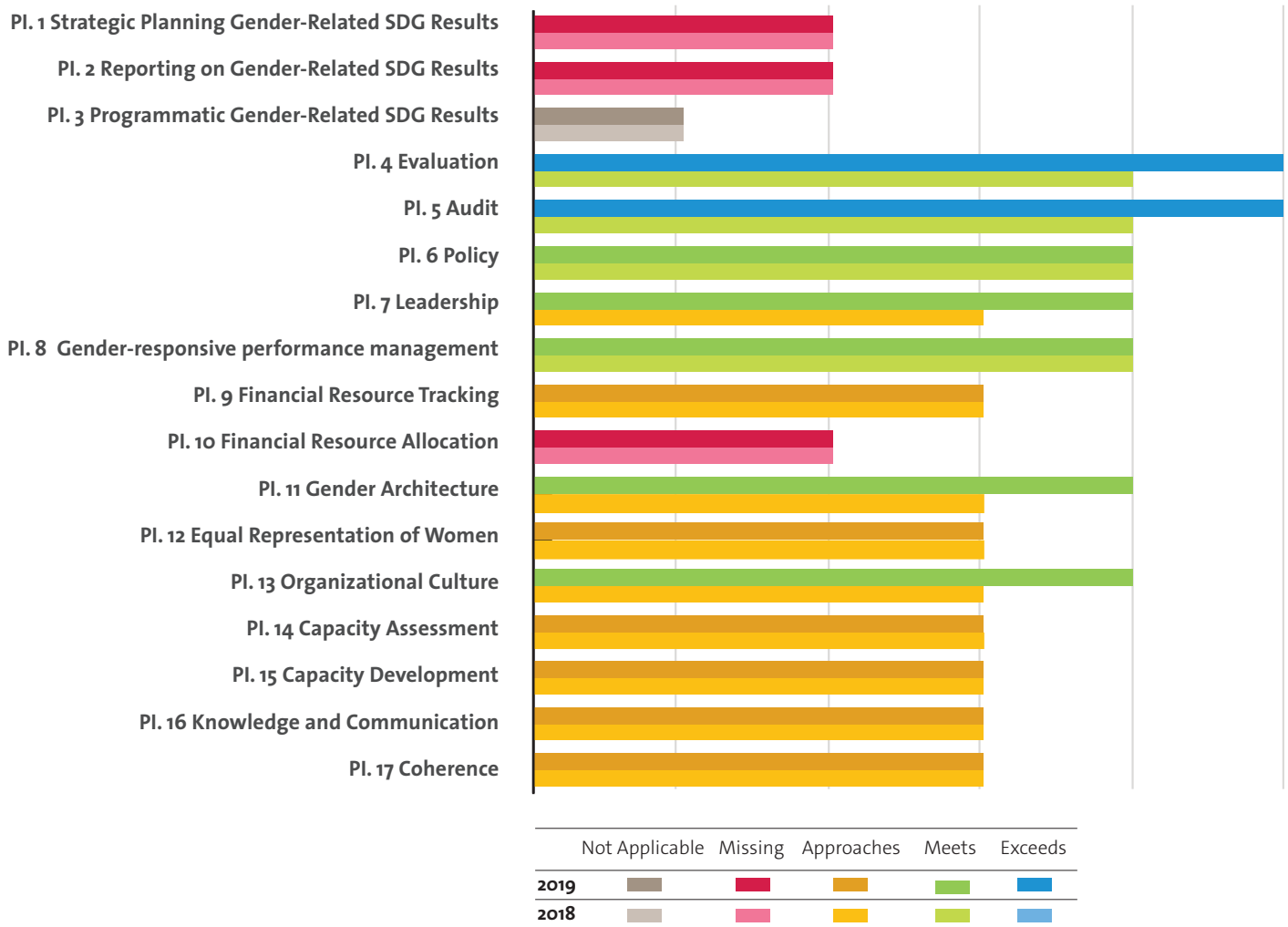

UN-SWAP 2.0 PERFORMANCE 2019

The following two pages capture WIPO's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2019.

In 2019, WIPO met or exceeded the requirements for 7 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, a significant improvement from 2018 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2019

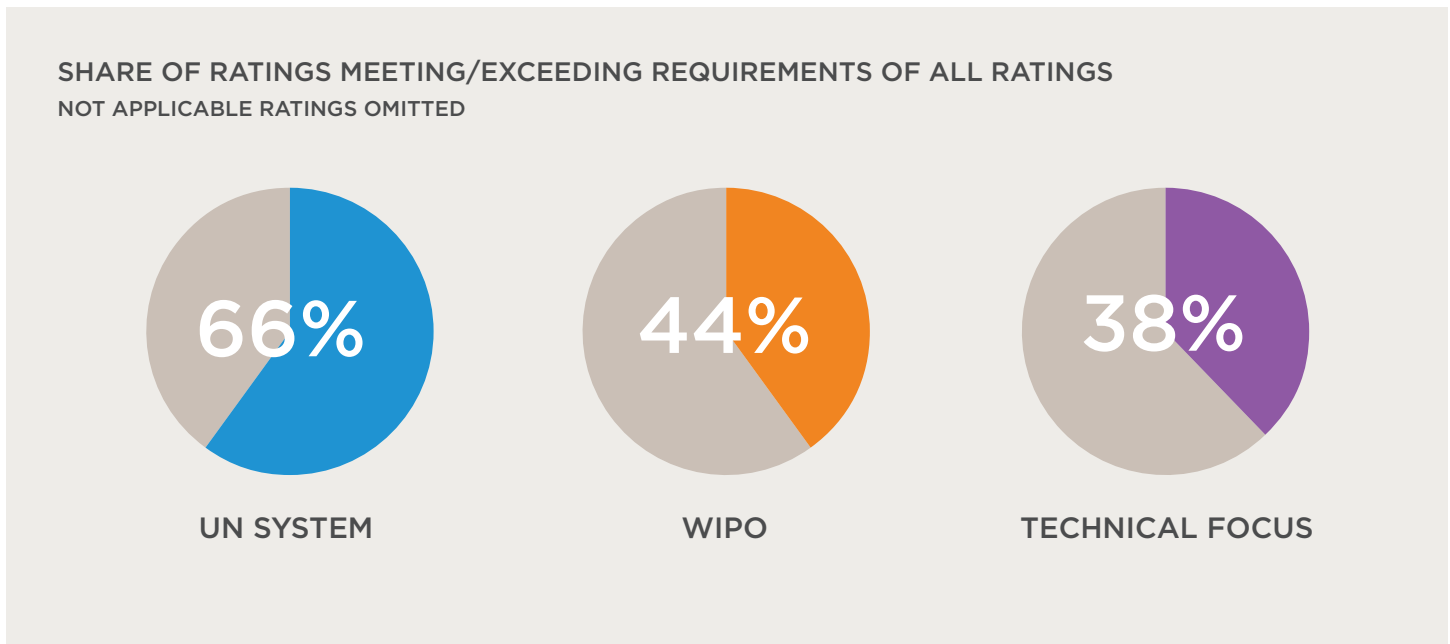
Most significant gains

- WIPO is newly exceeding requirements for two indicators, Evaluation and Audit, demonstrating the entity’s strongest performance to date.
- WIPO is newly meeting requirements for three additional indicators: Leadership, Gender Architecture and Organizational Culture.

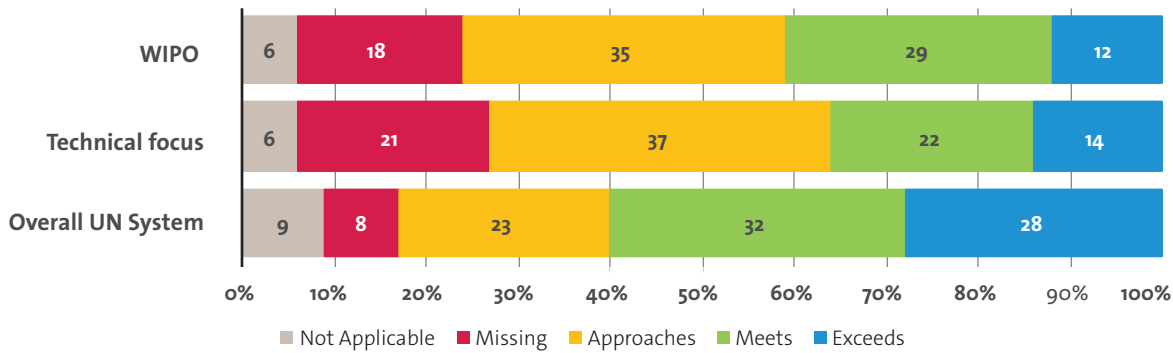
Areas for improvement

- While WIPO’s performance has seen an overall increase since 2018, room for improvement remains, particularly on the 3 indicators missing requirements: Strategic Planning and Reporting on Gender-Related SDG Results, as well as Financial Resource Allocation.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR WIPO

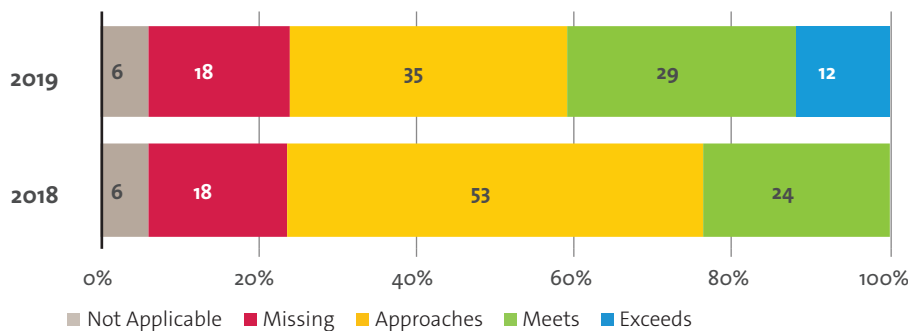


COMPARISON WITH TECHNICAL FOCUS ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM

• In 2019, WIPO performed better than the average for Technical entities and behind the average for the UN System at large.

WIPO, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2019, WIPO improved performance on 5 indicators, thereby increasing the percentage of indicators in the meeting or exceeding category by 17 percentage points from 2018.
