

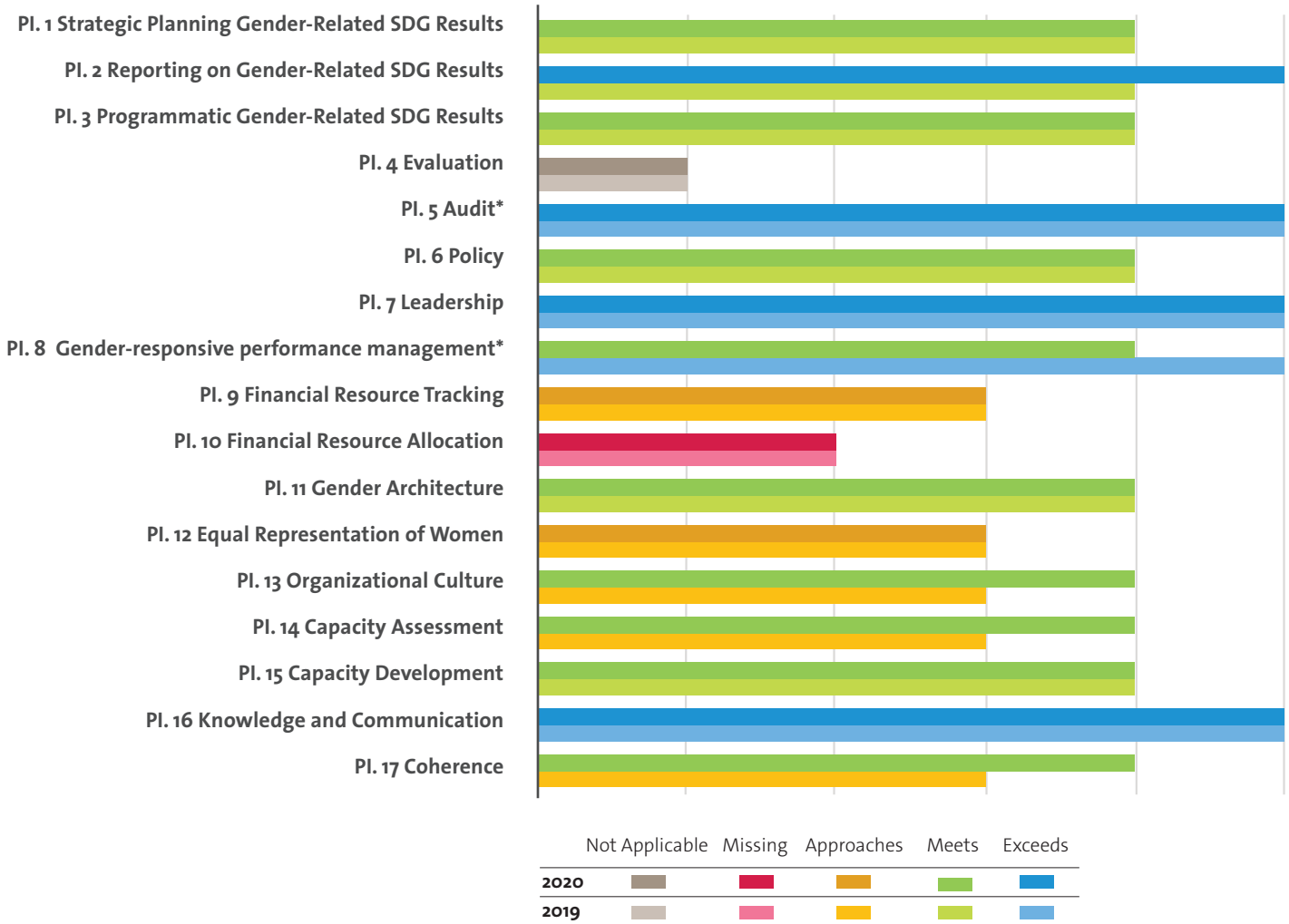

The following three pages capture ODA's performance on UN-SWAP 2.0 indicators for 2020.

In 2020, ODA met or exceeded the requirements for 13 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, a significant improvement from 2019 results.

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2020

Most significant gains

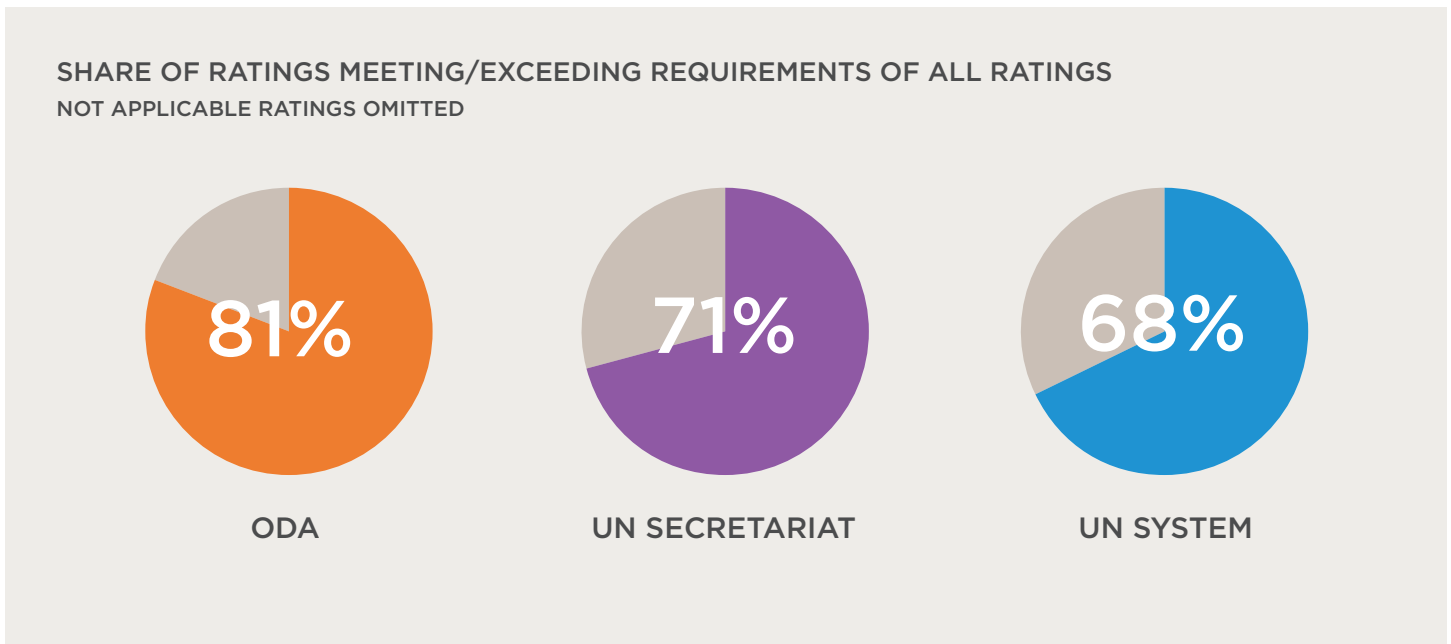
- In 2020, ODA exceeded the requirements for four indicators and met them for another nine indicators.
- Significantly, ODA newly exceeded Reporting on gender-related SDG results and newly met three indicators: Organizational culture, Capacity assessment and Coherence.

Areas for improvement

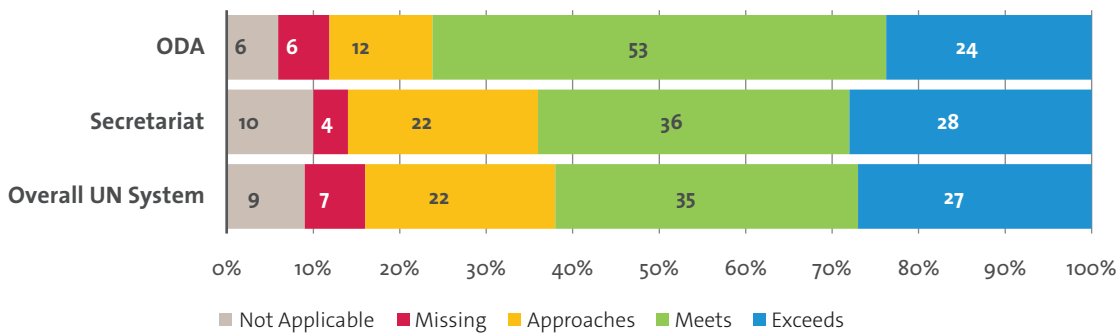
- UN Women encourages ODA to focus on the one area rated as missing and the remaining two areas rated as approaching requirements.

* Performance Indicators 5 on Audit and 8 on Gender-responsive performance management are jointly reported for all UN Secretariat entities by OIOS and DMSPC, respectively.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS FOR ODA

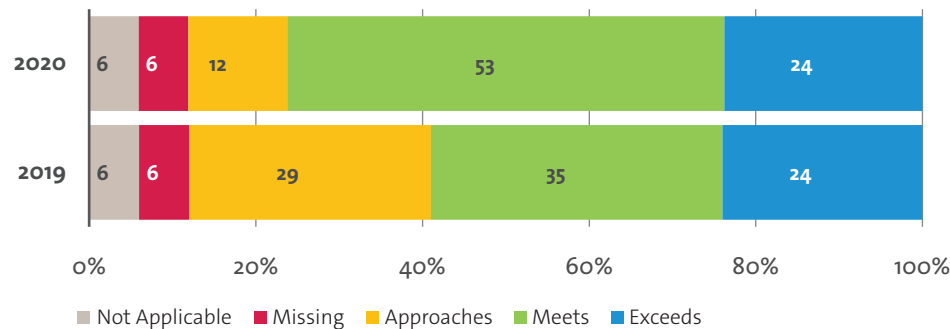


COMPARISON WITH THE SECRETARIAT AS A WHOLE AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
