

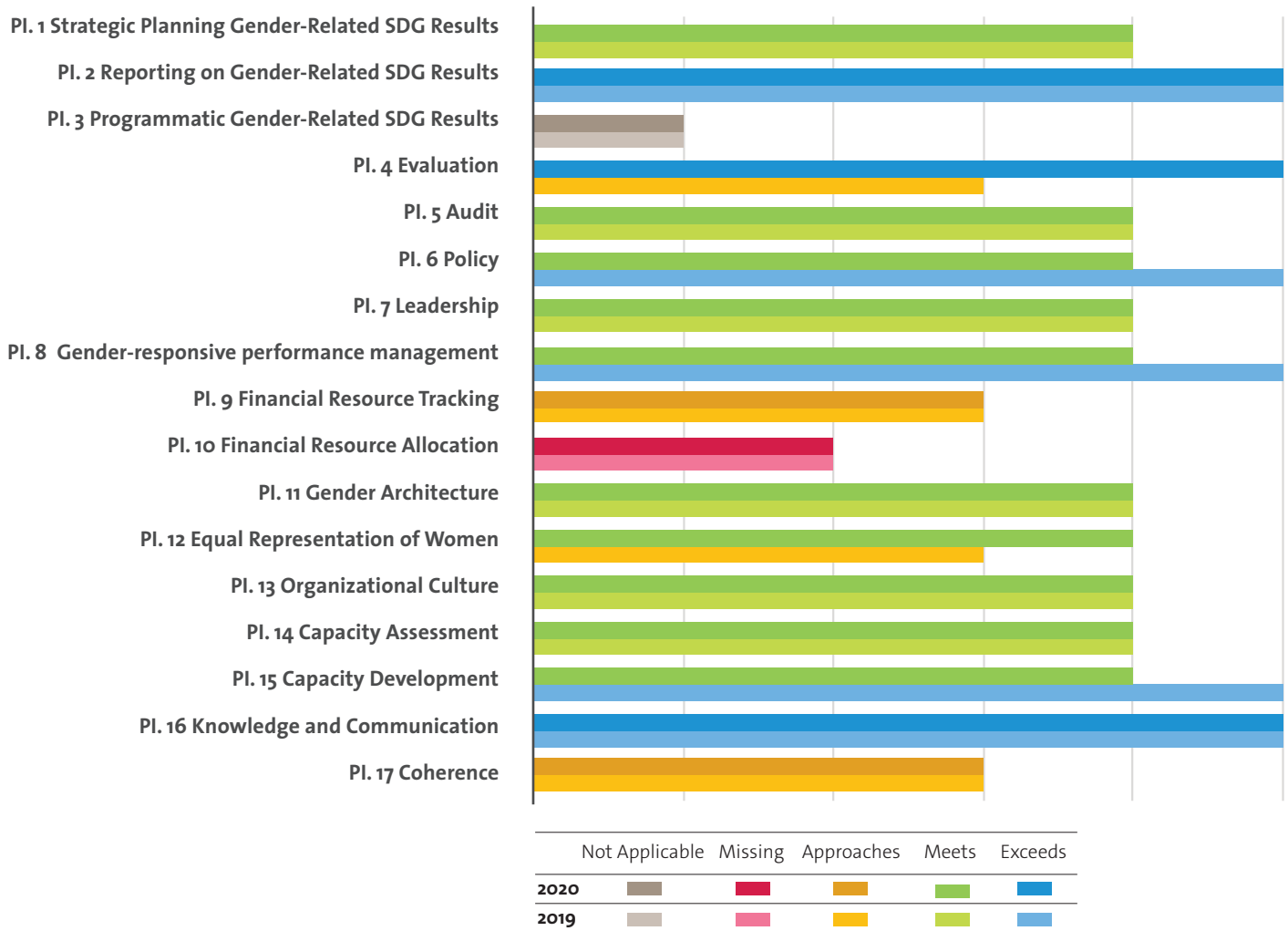

In 2020, UNESCO met or exceeded the requirements for 13 performance indicators out of 16 applicable, a significant improvement from 2019 performance.

Most significant gain

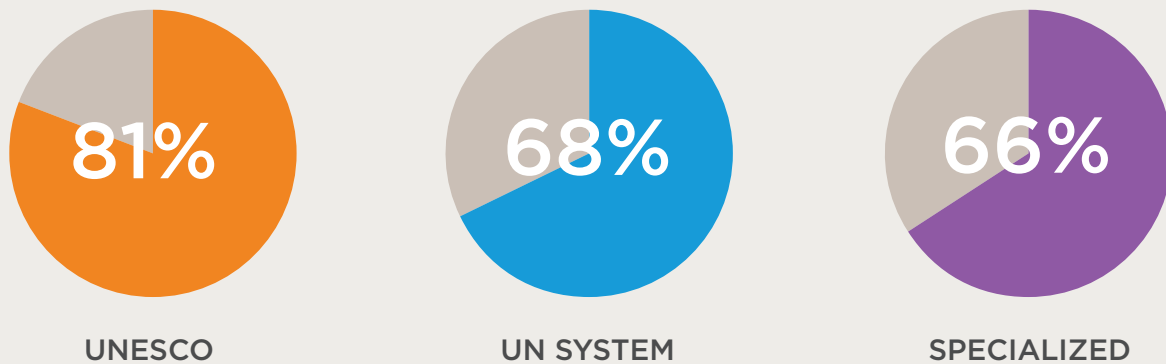
- In 2020, UNESCO exceeded the requirements for three indicators and met them for another 10 indicators.
- UNESCO newly exceeded requirements for Evaluation and met the requirements for Equal representation of women.

Areas for improvement

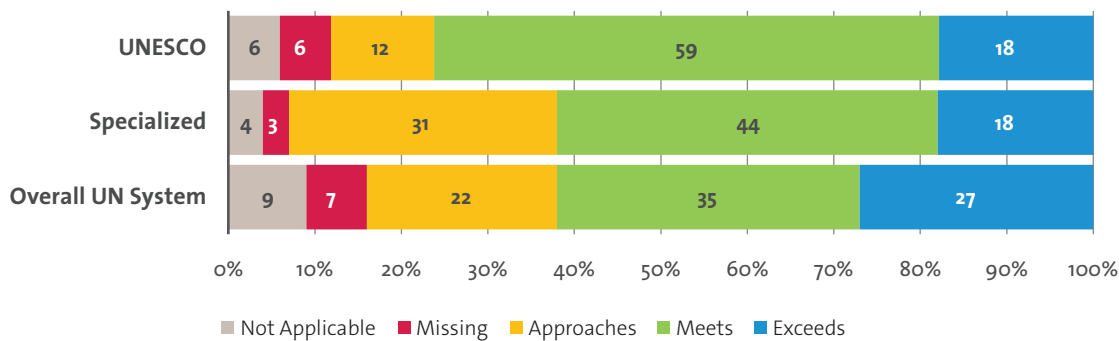
- UN Women recommends prioritizing Financial resource allocation, which missed requirements in 2020, as well as the two remaining indicators that approached requirements.

NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED

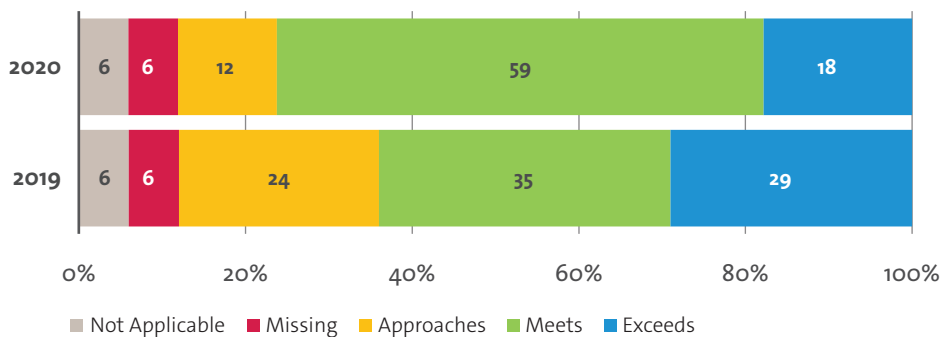


COMPARISON WITH SPECIALIZED ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM



In 2020, UNESCO met or exceeded requirements for more indicators than both the average for the Specialized entities and the overall UN system.

UNESCO, COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF RATINGS BY YEAR



In 2020, UNESCO met or exceeded the requirements for 77 per cent of all the 17 UN-SWAP performance indicators, including those rated as not applicable, registering a significant 13-percentage point increase from 2019.
