

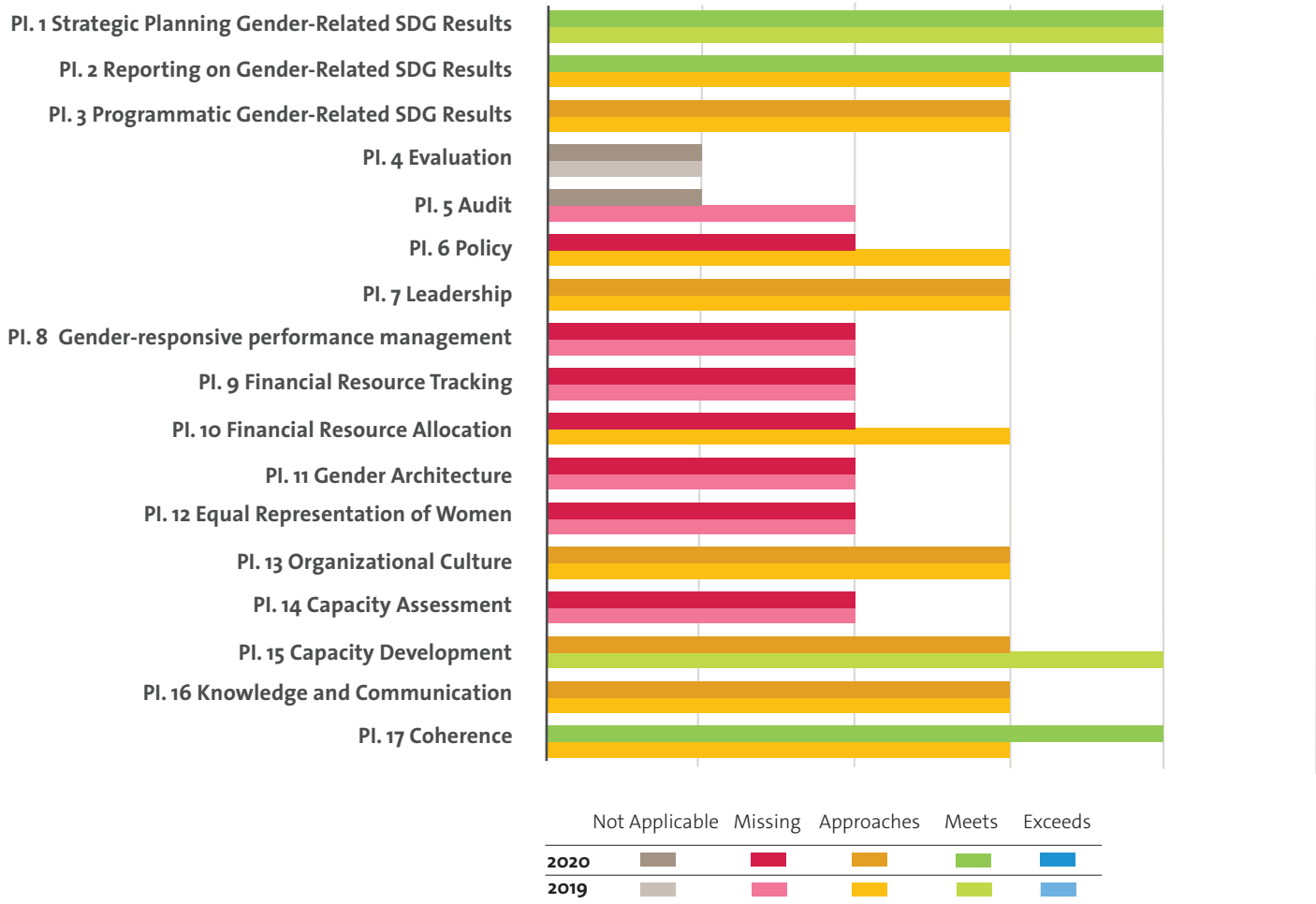

Most significant gains

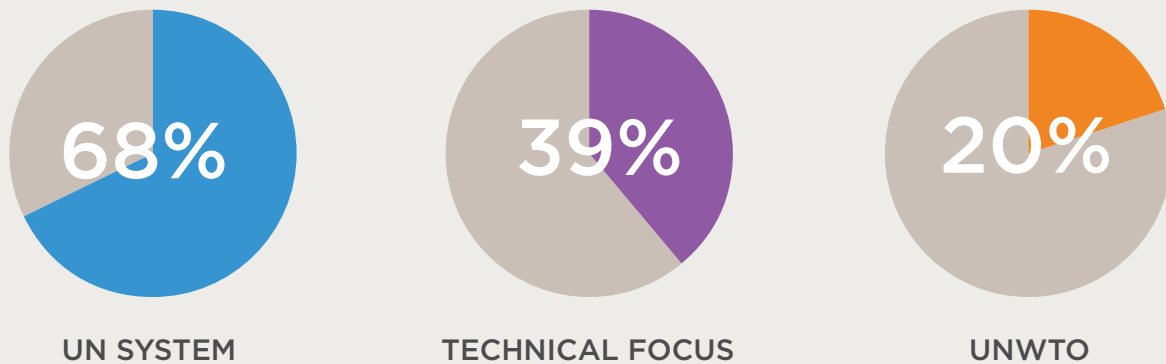
- In 2020, UNWTO met the requirements for three indicators.

Areas for improvement

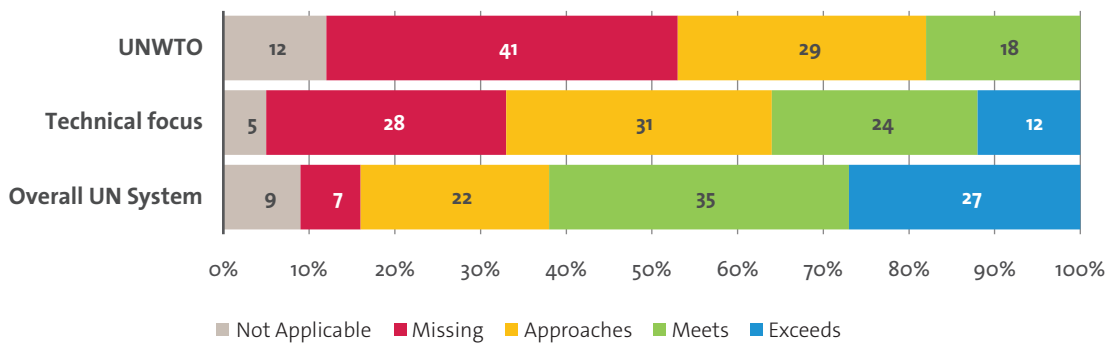
- UN Women encourages UNWTO to focus on the seven indicators missing requirements and the five indicators approaching requirements.

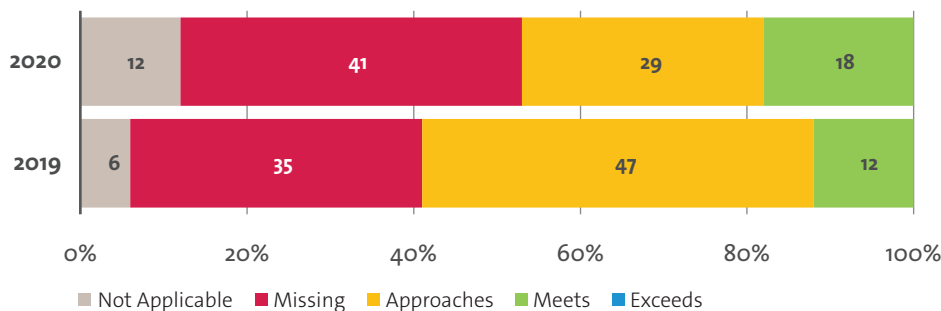


COMPARISON WITH TECHNICAL FOCUS ENTITIES AND THE OVERALL UN SYSTEM
