Benchmarking with relevant policies of other UN agencies






Policy in line with contextual changes in **UN-Women and the UN system (UN reform)** and the establishment of the Independent Evaluation and Audit Services (IEAS)

Non-substantive changes to better reflect **updated UNEG Norms** and Standards, **modern evaluation practices** and to improve readability




Separation of evaluation management content to streamline the policy document

EVALUATION BUDGET RANGE


from 1.5% to 3% of programme expenditure

EVALUATION GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

Strengthened Advisory Committee on Oversight (ACO)



- + The ACO replaces the GEAC and assumes greater role
- + The ACO terms of reference and membership strengthened in 2019
- + The ACO advises the Executive Director on a range of issues including on the policy, strategy, work plan and quality assurance of the evaluation function
- + The ACO reports annually to the Executive Board
